4. No Packet Mix allowed unless stated.
5. Third place will be given at the Judge's discretion.
6. All slice pieces are to be cut to 5cm square.
7. Decorated Cakes/Cupcakes are to be judged on decoration only.
8. When stated, *Recipe provided*, the recipe must be used.
9. All Jam Drops are to be baked using the traditional method with jam placed in each biscuit before baking in a moderate oven until golden brown. Jam to be dark red only.

COOKERY SECTION RECIPE

PEACH BLOSSOM - FEATURE CAKE

Division 1 – L13 and Division 2 L35

Ingredients: 4 oz butter, 1 cup sugar, whites – 4 eggs, ½ cup milk, 1 cup Plain Flour, ½ cup corn flour, 1 teaspoon Baking Powder, pinch salt.

Method: Beat butter and sugar, add beaten whites, then milk and flour, cornflour and salt (sifted). Divide into two and colour one part pink. Place in tin and blend colours with a knife. Bake 40 minutes – ice with pale pink butter icing.
