# RON LLOYD MEMORIAL 10<sup>th</sup> ANNIVERSARY CLASSIC CAR & MOTORCYCLE RALLY

8.30am start (Bell Golf Club Entrance)

The **Ron Lloyd Memorial Car and Bike Run** is in honour of Mr Ron Lloyd who was not only a stalwart of Rural Shows but was a great Car and Motorcycle enthusiast. Ron had a great love for Bell and District.

The rally run is a staged time trial where participants are required to nominate the time it will take them to complete each stage of the run.

**NOTE:** This year, there is a **change to the rules** and for each stage there will be a “judge’s time.” This time will not be disclosed to participants. **Participants who take longer than the “judge’s time” will incur a time penalty of 1 point per second above the “judge’s time”.** Participants who have a time less than the “judge’s time” do not incur any penalties.

There will be **three (3) stages**. Maps of the course will be made available on the morning of the event. Each participant must have their **nominated times** for each stage presented to the stewards no later than **30 minutes before the commencement** of the run.

For each stage there will be a number of **questions or activities** the participants will be required to complete. Incorrect or unanswered questions incur a **time penalty**. The questions and activities will be presented to each participant at the **commencement of each stage**. At the completion of the stage the **answer sheet for the questions** is to be given to the steward **prior to commencement of the next stage**. There are no activities for motorcycles.

- Each car must have a minimum of two (2) people. A driver and a navigator.
- One or two persons per motor-bike, (pillion passenger or side-car is acceptable)
- All vehicles must be roadworthy and have current registration.
- Each driver/rider must have a current driver’s licence
- All road rules must be complied with during the event.

## LINE HONOURS:

This year there is a “Line Honours” event where for each class the participant who completes the run (all three stages) in the shortest time will be declared the winner.

## TEAM EVENT: (Not included in the Line Honours event)

- A team consists of **five (5) cars**
- The team must nominate four (4) cars for each stage at the conclusion of the event. (One car is dropped out for each stage)
- Nominated cars for each stage are to be presented to the stewards no later than 30 minutes before presentation time.

- The points for the four (4) nominated cars will be tallied for each stage to give the overall number of points.
- The team with the lowest number of points will be declared the winner.
- If more than one team has the same number of points, then the team with the lowest total nominated time will be declared the winner.

#### **CAR RALLY POKER:**

At the commencement of **each stage** the participant will be given an envelope with a **playing card**. At the **finish line** each participant will receive **two envelopes each with one playing card**. Each participant will then have five (5) playing cards making a poker hand. A participant can **discard up to two (2) cards** and purchase **replacement cards** at a cost of **\$5.00 per card**. This transaction can only occur **once**. The participant with the **best poker hand will win a prize**.

There are also **specially marked cards** mixed into the pack. A participant may be fortunate enough to receive one or more of these. The participant with the **best hand of specially marked cards will win a prize**.

#### **ENTRY FEES:**

- **\$50.00 per car**
- **\$25.00 per motorcycle**
- **\$25.00 per motorcycle with pillion passenger or side-car.**
- **Team event \$25/car (\$125 for a team)**
- **Team event \$10/bike (\$50 for a team)**
- **Entry into the show is complimentary for car and bike rally participants.**

ENTRY FEES ARE **NOT REFUNDABLE**

**STARTING TIME first car leaves 8.30 am      Marshalling of cars/ bikes from 6.30 am**

**Time nominations required by 8.00 am      Briefing of participants 8.15 am**

**Nominations can be made online by accessing [www.bellshowcarrally.com](http://www.bellshowcarrally.com) or the Bell Show website. Participants who choose to nominate online will receive a \$5:00 discount.**

**Online nominations close at 5:00 PM on the Thursday prior to the event.**

Nomination forms are available on the Bell Show website. Nominations will be accepted on the morning of the event.

- Cars will leave first from oldest to newest, followed by motorcycles from oldest to newest, unless there are special circumstances. This is at the discretion of the stewards.
- Starting interval will be thirty seconds.
- Starting time and finishing time for each leg will be recorded for each vehicle.
- The participant can remain at the check point for as long as they choose before starting the next stage.
- Upon arriving at the checkpoint, the time will be recorded. The participant will give the stage question sheet answers to the steward prior to the commencement of the next stage.
- The questions for the stage are presented to the participant at the commencement of that stage. The participant will also receive a playing card for "Car Rally Poker" at the commencement of each stage.

## Points system.

- The nominated time for each stage is to be presented to stewards before the start of the event.
- Arrive at check point at the nominated time = 0 points
- For every second before or after the nominated time participants accumulate 1 point.
- For every second above the “judge’s time” participants accumulate 1 point.
- **Time penalties** for activities. Correct answer no penalty, incorrect answer 3 minutes, question not attempted 7 minutes.
- The **lowest number of points** for each stage wins. The lowest number of points accumulated over the three stages wins the event.
- If two or more participants have the same number of points, then the participant with the **shortest nominated time** will be declared the winner for that stage and for the overall event.
- A four (4) hour limit is placed on the event. If a participant does not complete the event within four (4) hours of the starting time they will be considered as **Did Not Finish**
