JUDGING TIME: 11.00am. Trophies will be presented immediately after judging.

REGULATIONS: All Rules and Regulations of the Bell Show Society must be adhered to in addition to the ones below. These can be found on the Bell Show Society website: www.bellshowandrodeo.com.au

1. All exhibits must be polled, dehorned or well tipped.
2. Entries must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor for 3 months prior to the Show.
3. Classes 1 & 2 are for grain fed and grain assisted cattle. Only pasture and crop fed cattle may be entered in Classes 3 - 18 (no grain supplementing allowed in Classes 3 - 18).
4. Pre-judging weighing will commence at 7am Saturday. Weights, as outlined in the program, will be strictly adhered to. The stewards have the right to change entries if required after weighing. No curfew on weights.
5. Stewards reserve the right to mouth any beast at their discretion.
6. Exhibits will be marked with paint class numbers when weighed.
7. All cattle to remain on the grounds until 3pm Saturday.
8. Champions can be selected from single or pen Classes.
9. If the Judge decides that the exhibit of any Class is not worthy, no prize will be awarded.
10. All cattle exhibited remain the property of the owner, there will be no auction sale.
11. Supreme Champion can be selected from Pasture or Grain Fed, out of all cattle shown in Prime Section, Classes 1 - 13.
12. Society ribbon and card presented to all Champions.

GRAIN FED CLASSES, ACCREDITED and GRAIN ASSISTED, C1 – C2

Please note due to the variance of cattle numbers each year if there are big classes of grain fed nominated, we will split steer and heifer classes into different weights on the day. Prize Money will be awarded for the amended classes.

Entry Fee: \$10/pen

REGULATIONS:

1. All Bulls must be on the grounds before 7am on Saturday of the show
2. All Bulls must be under 24 months as at 28th February 2026
3. Bulls are to be quiet and unled. Bulls that are misbehaving will be loaded back on trucks. *(It is in the best interests of your stud to have quiet bulls for the public to view)*
4. Stud and Sale signage can be put on display after Judging
