REGULATIONS: (in addition to the Bell Show Society's General Rules and Regulations)

1. All cattle must be on the grounds by 9.00am for judging on Saturday 2nd March 2024.
2. Open to all Stud Cattle (Beef) of all breeds.
3. All cattle entered and on the grounds must be presented for judging.
4. All cattle will be housed in open stalls. Exhibitors are to bring their own bedding and collect all their baling twine.
5. All cattle must be registered in the Herd Book of their Breed. Any not registered by reason of age must have calf certificates. Age at 1st March 2024.
6. It will be imperative that all cattle be tied up in Stud Beef Section and **all bulls over 12 months of age must have a nose ring**. This rule will be strictly enforced.

LED STEER or HEIFER COMPETITION

Weighing at 7am. Judging beginning at approximately 8am.
Depending on numbers on the day, classes may be altered.

Open to Schools and Colleges Only

- B1 Led Steer or Heifer Milk Tooth, under 450kg – 1st - \$50, 2nd - \$30, 3rd - \$20.
- B2 Led Steer or Heifer Milk Tooth over 450kg, - 1st - \$50, 2nd - \$30, 3rd - \$20

Open to everyone

- B3 Led Steer or Heifer, Milk Tooth, under 350kg. 1st - \$50, 2nd - \$30, 3rd - \$20
- B4 Led Steer or Heifer, Milk Tooth, 350kg – 450kg, 1st - \$50, 2nd - \$30, 3rd - \$20
- B5 Led Steer or Heifer, Milk Tooth, over 450kg, 1st - \$50, 2nd - \$30, 3rd - \$20

BEEF YOUNG JUDGES' (Led Cattle) & PARADERS' COMPETITIONS

YOUNG JUDGES' & PARADERS' RULES

The **Hormel slide** must be used at all levels in the Young Judging Competitions.

To be eligible for the State Finals, competitors must comply with all of these rules.

Local Show Rules

1. Competitors must be over 15 and under 25 years on 1 May in the year of the State Final.
2. Competitors under 18 years must have the approval of a parent or guardian to compete.
3. Competitors are to be a resident in Queensland for at least three months prior to competing or attending an educational institution in Queensland unless they qualify under Rule (4).
4. Competitors residing over the border who can prove an affinity with a Queensland Show are allowed entry provided they satisfy one of the following criteria:
 - (a) Their address has a Queensland postcode;
 - (b) They have a Queensland phone number;
 - (c) The competitor or their parents are active working members of that Show.
5. National winners or National Judging Panel for that event are ineligible to compete.

Sub-Chambers Rules

Rules (1 – 5) in the Local Show Rules apply to all Sub-Chamber Finals.

6. Sub-Chambers will decide the number of competitors from each Show who will compete at the Final.
7. Competitors can represent only one Show in the Sub-Chamber Final.
8. A State Final Entry Form must be completed by the winner of each Competition immediately after judging and forwarded to the QCAS State Office by the Sub-Chamber Secretary / Coordinator.
9. The contestants placed first or second in this Regional contest will be eligible to compete in the Darling Downs Final at the **Dalby Showgrounds on Saturday 18th May 2024**. The winner will go to Brisbane Royal Show to participate in the Beef Young Judges' Competition in Brisbane. First \$160. Second \$80. Any young person who enters an Agricultural Show on the Darling Downs and receives a form from that Show Society may then enter the Darling Downs Young Judges' and Paraders' Competition. Competitors must be 25 years and under on 1 May in the year of the State Final.

BEEF YOUNG JUDGES' COMPETITION

Competitors will judge a selection of exhibited cattle with points awarded for judging exhibits in line with the official judging. The Judge's decision is final.

No Entry Fee.

Classes: Under 15 years 15 Years to 25 years

Winners in 15 to 25 Years class will qualify for Sub Chamber finals for Young Judges.

Prize money: 1st - \$10, 2nd - \$5 donated by Robyn Sorley, Alma Park Brahman Stud, Bell.

3rd and 4th places - Ribbons

YOUNG PARADERS' COMPETITION

Competitors will be judged on their ability to handle their animal.

The competition will be held on completion of the Stud Cattle judging.

The Judge's decision is final.

No Entry Fee. Dust coats required.

Classes: Under 12 years 12 Years to 14 years 15 to 25 years

Prize money for each class: 1st - \$6, 2nd - \$4, 3rd and 4th places - Ribbons

Joseph Hawton Memorial Trophy donated by Wayne, Michelle and Sam Hawton for Young Handlers under 12 years of age.

Winners in 15 to 25 Years class will qualify for Sub Chamber finals for Young Paraders.

JENSEN / DAY SHIELD – ANNUAL SCHOOLS COMPETITION

1. Points will be awarded to competitors under 15 from Schools in the Led Steer / Heifer Competition, Stud Cattle Classes (animal must be owned by the young exhibitor), Young Judges' Competition and Paraders' Competition.
2. Points are awarded on a 3, 2, 1 basis for first, second and third respectively. No points will be awarded for Champions, Reserve Champions, Pairs or Group Classes.
